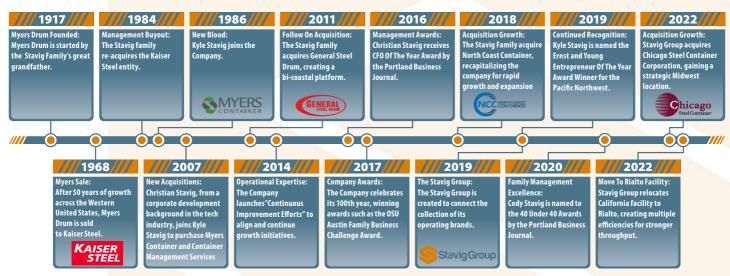
INDEPENDENTS STRONGER TOGETHER

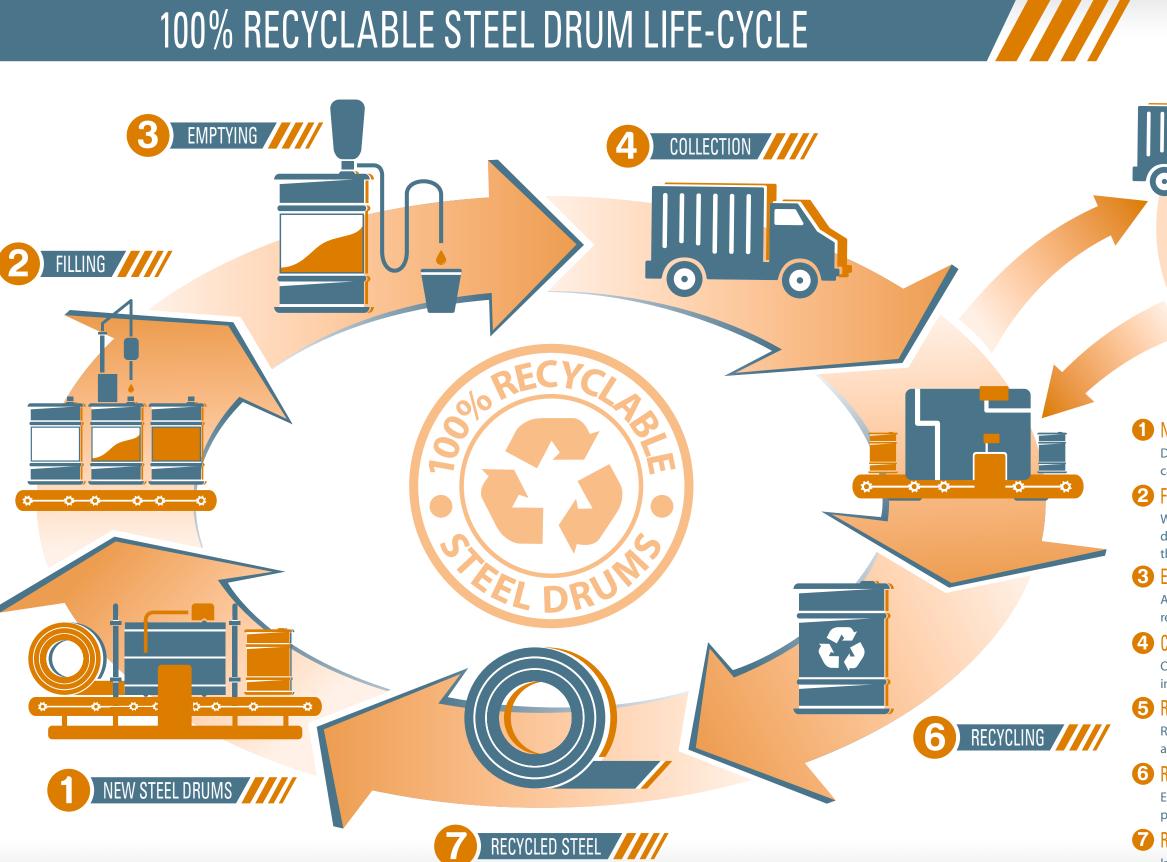




OUR VISION

RECONDITIONING ////

2 FILLING

With its ability to be reused, reconditioned and recycled, the steel drum is among the safest, most environmentally sound packaging in the world.

3 EMPTYING

After customers utilize the various contents of their drums, they are ready for collection.

4 COLLECTION

Only certified drip-dry empty drums, that have the original labels intact and all the closures secure are accepted for reconditioning.

5 RECONDITIONING

Reconditioning and reusing steel drums conserves natural resources and keeps drums out of landfills.

6 RECYCLING

Empty steel drums that can no longer be reconditioned are sanitized prior to being sent off to be recycled back into steel.

7 RECYCLED STEEL

Infinitely recyclable, that worn out empty steel drum ends up back in the steel process.





SOURCING SUPPLIERS

We source domestically produced raw materials when available to support "American Made" products and companies. We also actively canvas and engage disadvantaged suppliers to help support unified business growth.

We are committed to building a strong continuous improvement environment based on the Toyota Production System for our team members. We work closely with lean manufacturing consortia to provide training. Every team member on the shop floor has a skills matrix to progress on skills and pay. All others in the company are on the Individual Performance Goal (IPG) for career development.

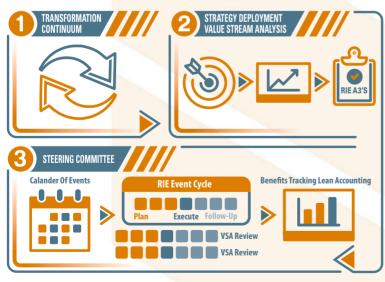

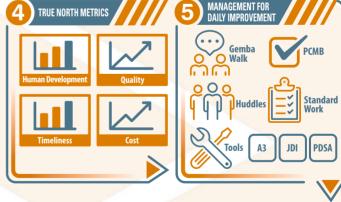
Every facility has active safety teams that continuously insure and improve upon the safety of the workplace.

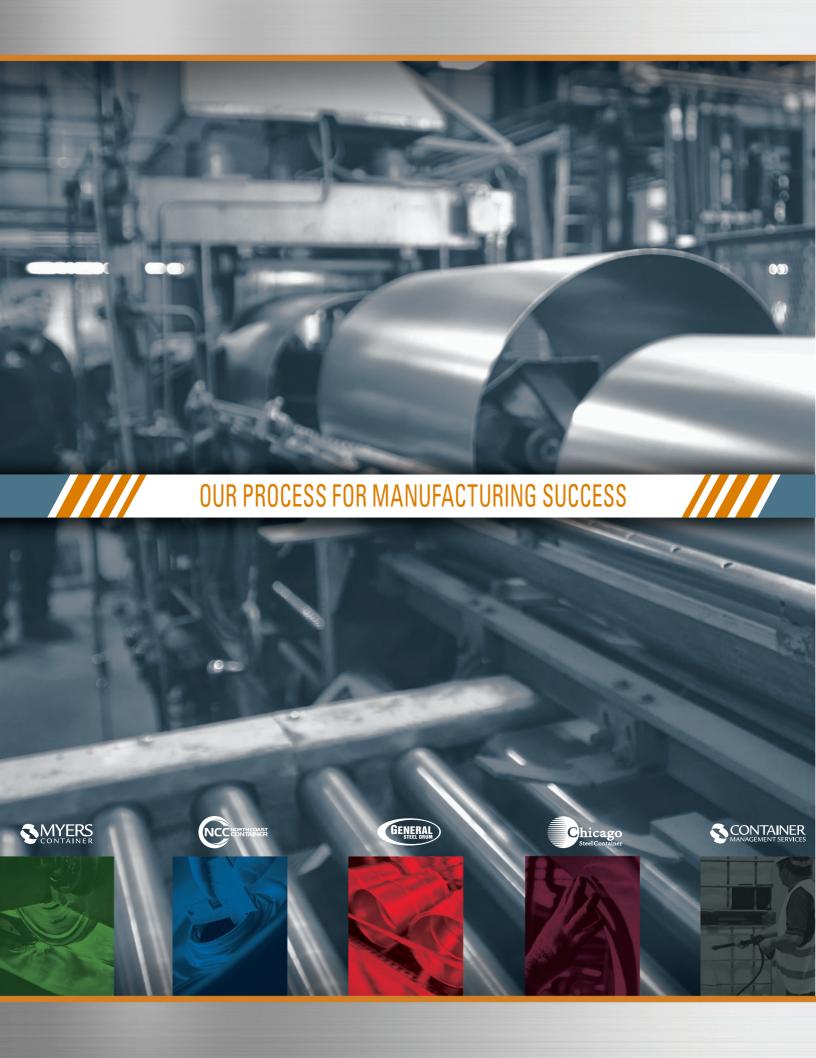

MANUFACTURING SUSTAINABILITY

Our successful manufacturing formula focuses on superior container quality, complete life-cycle services and continuous company and product improvement.

SOURCING

We acquire 30% of our steel which is 75% less CO2, from an Electric Arc Furnace process versus the traditional Blast Oxygen Furnace process. When sourcing paint and coatings we utilize

low emission coatings and recycled paints to protect the environment. We also source non-hazardous chemicals, improving safety and reducing hazardous toxins and energy consumption.



MANUFACTURING

We manufacture a complete line of cold-rolled carbon steel drums in a variety of sizes and types.





RECONDITIONING

We offer secure and environmentally friendly reconditioning services for steel drums, plastic drums, and bulk containers to the highest standard.



RECYCLING

We offer a secure recycling process where industrial materials are cleaned and sanitized before leaving our premises. We repurpose all drum

manufacturing materials for reconditioning for new raw materials. We utilize balers for recycling corrugated materials. Generates 4-6 tons of material per month for recycling. We reduced the use of stretch wrap switching to reusable rubber bands. Through these processes we've diverted 250 million pounds of material from the landfill through reuse and recycling since 2007.



COLLECTION

We offer RoundTrip™ Collection for used IBCs, steel and plastic drums and recyclable plastics



ENERGY

We collaborate with Energy Trusts in our region, developing action plans, reduce energy consumption. At least 10% of our power is sourced from renewable energy at our facilities. We

utilize lower energy lighting in our facilities, reducing energy consumption and its impact on the environment. We installed new high efficiency ovens at our facilities.



WATER

We do not discharge processed water to the Public Owned Treatment Works (POTW), supporting being a zero discharge participant. We are also

utilizing a more environmentally friendly wash system that saves 25% on energy and uses 40% less water.



EMISSIONS

We monitor emissions to maintain compliance within our operating permits. We are always exploring and developing new technologies to reduce our footprint. We are

continuously minimizing our footprint through rooftop consolidations, reducing emissions and energy output focusing on sustainability.

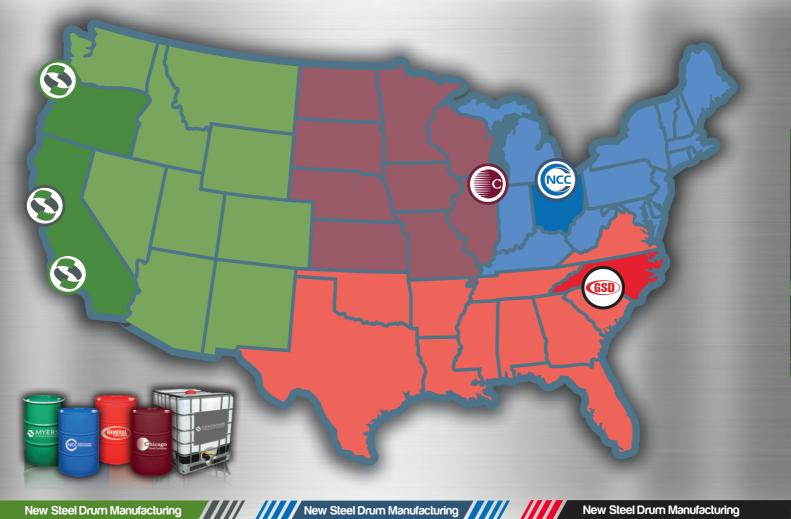
